
Very spacious and well equipped labs with latest and modern apparatuses to serve the purpose to carry our various experiments are the centre of learning.

### **OUR RECREATIONAL ZONE**



# ANINNOVATIVE ENDEAVOUR

AN INNOVATIVE ENDEAVOUR

Bedi International envisages a plethora of innovations to bring forth a holistic approach for the overall development of a child. The famous gospel 'Child is the educator of man' holds good at our Institute as we earnestly aspire to garnish the innate talents of a child and mould him to be the future educator of our nation. Some of our innovations are enumerated as under

### **INNOVATIVE ASSEMBLY**

Assembly in the morning marks the beginning of a day in our School. In this citadel of learning students line up, fold their hands together to sing out the prayers and hymns enlightening their religious vistas. Classwise Assembly Presentation is promoted in which the students come up roll-numberwise to read out the news, pledge, a moral thought, views on a topic, G.K. questions and amazing facts.

Vocabulary Enrichment is an important integral of Morning Assembly. Each day a new word is given to the students with its meaning. They have to memorise it and the next day they are asked to tell the word, its meaning and frame a sentence for it. Credit points are awarded to children who participate in Assembly, as a motivation. Birthday Celebration of children during Assembly is also an important feature of the school. Special Assembly is organized on specific days e.g. Earth Day, No Tobacco Day, World Aids Day, etc to create an awareness among the students.

## SPECIAL CAREER DEVELOPMENT MODULE (SCDM)

Evolving the concept of Finishing School, this module has been meticulously designed. From class III onwards every child is subjected to various club activities according to his interest. The clubs include Creative Designing, Performing Acts, Public Administration, I.T. Club, Eco-Club, Science Model Club, Personality grooming & English Communication club and Games & Sports. Thereafter the students are counselled and helped to shape their career according to their respective interests and talents.

### **CREDIT EVALUATION**

To motivate the students and to boost up their morale positive credit points are given to them in various spheres which include Random to maintain discipline on the campus various negative points are also given to students for every default they may commit.

Random Questioning Sessions (RQS) Quest (questions asked by students from the Faculty), Homework completion, Assembly participation, Communication in English, Competition and Project participation. Children with highest Credit Points in whole class as well as whole school are awarded during prize distribution ceremony which is held at the end of the year. Simultaneously, to maintain discipline on the campus various negative points are also given to students for every default they may commit.

### **PLANNED HOMEWORK**

Worksheet concept is followed while planning the homework. Creative and analytical worksheets are designed for the students based on the work done in the respective classes. Students are given grades for the same. Homework days for specific subjects are fixed in the Homework Planner.

Revision Assignments are also provided at the end of every chapter to the students, fixed in the Homework Planner. Revision Assignments are also provided at the end of every chapter to the students.

### **ACADEMIC APPROACH**

The school's is affiliated to the CBSE, Delhi. The course of studies offered and pursued at the school is as prescribed by the CBSE for the 10+2 system. Much emphasis is given to current affairs, reasoning and aptitude tests also. They are included in the curriculum to

keep our children updated and to equip them well to face competiotions.

The school curriculum up to class XII is based on the recommendations of NCERT. Evaluation is being carried out for all classes from VI to IX and XI as per the guidelines issued by the CBSE from time to time. Evaluation of Academic subjects will be carried out in Two Unit Assessments and Two Terms distributed over the year. Co-scholastic activities, attitudes & values and health & physical education will also be evaluated once a year. Promotion will be based on the day-to-day work of the students throughout the year and also on the performance in the Terminal Examination. Oral Assessments, Projects, Notebooks and Assignments are also carried out from time to time.

### **ENGLISH COMMUNICATION**

English is the compulsory campus language of the Institution. Lot of emphasis is given on the communication skills of the students. Conducive environment in the campus is provided for the same. Regular classes are held for communication using power point presentations and Mp3 clips for language training. For motivating the students positive credit points are given to a student if he continuously communicates in English throughout the month and negative points are given to those students who are found not communicating in English.

English communication Lab would soon be set up to further enhance the concept.

### **REGULAR CONCEPTUAL ASSESSMENT**

Assessment of students is not only limited to terminal examinations and Unit Tests in our school. Infact an approach of regular student assessment is followed in which after completion of every chapter self study sessions are conducted for the students in which they are made to learn every chapter in the school and their doubts (if any) from the concerned teacher and thereafter Class Tests are conducted for every chapter. In this manner regular assessment of children are kept under surveillance of teachers.



## SCHOOL RULES

Bedi International School set under the aegis of Guru Granth Sahib Educational Society is a co-educational School which follows CBSE pattern. It follows a code of conduct which forms the ethos of this citadel of learning.

### **DISCIPLINARY RULES**

- As per CBSE norms 75% attendance is compulsory for a child to appear in the examination else he/she will be debarred from writing the exams.
- Students should treat school staff with respect at all times and be courteous to fellow students.
- Students will refrain from damaging any form of school property. The school reserves the right to be compensated by the student for any such damages.
- Unacceptable behaviour including academic dishonesty, neglect of homework, disruptive behaviour, chewing of bubble gum in school, hitting other children within school campus or outside and disrespectful behaviour towards staff or fellow students will lead to immediate suspension of the child.
- For safety and security, parents should refrain from sending money valuables (like expensive jewellery, electronic items, etc.) to school with their child.
- Only parents or registered guardians are entitled to attend the PTM of a child. Guardians must have an authority letters duly signed by the parents to attend the PTM.
- Students are expected to dress and behave in a manner appropriate to the membership of the school and should observe the prescribed uniform regulations throughout the school day and on occasions as announced by the school.
- Neat & tidy school uniform recommended by the school with ID Card must be worn daily by the students. Without the same will not be permitted in.
- Socks and shoes as per sample approved by the school must be worn by the students.

- Girls should have their hair plaited or tied neatly and non Sikh boys should have their hair trimmed and beards are not permitted. Hair may not be coloured, tinted or highlighted. NO FANCY HAIR CUT FOR BOYS OR GIRLS IS PERMITTED. The school believes insimplicity and students are not permitted to wear ostentatious or expensive items like jewellery, fancy watches, wristbands or similar accessories in the school. Only plain white colour hair bands, ribbons, rubber bands, belts etc. are allowed.
- Sweaters/Cardigans should be as recommended by school only. No other colours or fancy designs will be allowed in the school premises.
- Fingernails must be cut short and kept clean.
- Mobile and other portable devices like Ipads, Ipods, and Tablets etc. are not allowed to be used. And uploading of pics or videos on social media is not allowed. All such devices, if found, will be confiscated by a member of the school staff and will lead to immediate suspension of the child. Any misbehaviour or violation of school discipline will be dealt by the Disciplinary Committee and corrective action will be taken. In extreme cases parents will be called in to discuss the child's behaviour and may lead to suspension or expulsion from the school.

### **ADMISSION**

Parents seeking admission of their child will be required to first get their child registered. For this they would have to obtain a Registration Form and Prospectus from the School Reception on cash payment. Completed Registration Form should be submitted in the School's office. Registration once done will not be cancelled. Registration fees is non-refundable.

### **FEERULES**

- 1. Last date for depositing 1st Installment 2nd Installment 3rd Installment and 4th Installment are 15th April, 15th July, 15th Oct and 15th Jan respectively. For New Admission, fee must be deposited within 10 daysof the date of confirmation of admission.
- 2. Last fine will be imposed after the lapse of last date for the fee deposition in each quarter.
- 3. Scheduled & Amount of late fee will be as follows:

From 15th to 30th April/31st July/31st Oct/31st Jan Rs.50

From 01st to 15th May/15th Aug/15th Nov/15th Feb Rs.100

From 15th to 31st May/31st Aug/30th Nov/28th Feb Rs.200

From 01st to 30th Jun/ 01st to 30th Sep/01st to 30th Dec/01st to 30th Mar Rs.500

(After the lapse of above dates an additional late fee of Rs. 10 per day shall be charged above aforesaid late fine)

- 4. Above mentioned fine can be exempted in case of late deposition where school shall receive an application duly signed by parents mentioning the reason for late deposition of fees and also they must clearly mention the time by which they will be able to deposit the fee along with post dated cheque.
- 5. Also only one such application can be given in one quarter. Moreover, management must be satisfied with the reason mentioned in the application. This application must be given by parents themselves in the school office latest by 15th of first month of every quarter.
- 6. Whole month fee is chargeable if the student has attended the school even for a single day in a particular month.
- 7. Fee & other charges once paid, will not be refundable in any case even if the child has not attended the school for a single day.
- 8. All school dues are accepted in cash/cheque/card at school as well as Bank authorized by the school.
- 9. Each student will be issued a printed fee book indicating the amount payable which should be presented at the Bank Counter, duly filled in & signed in triplicate by the respective Parents/Guardian.
- 10. Two counter foils will be detached by the bank and

- the third copy is meant for the parents for their records.
- 11. Parent should preserve the receipt, to be produced, if demanded by the school.
- 12. In case of loss of fee book the school office should be informed immediately. A new fee book will be issued on payment of Rs.50 only.
- 13. Overwriting of any sort in the fee book will make it invalid in such cases, will not be accepted.
- 14. If any parent has deposited the fee by online transaction, they must send the copy of transaction slip with student's name, class & section mentioned on it on school's E-mail ID i.e. bediinternationalschool@gmail.com. and also confirm the same via telephonic call or whatsapp on 8881388802, 9997769148. Also if the fee is deposited late then parents must deposit the fee with late fine itself. In case fine is not deposited, it will remain standing in the fee dues of the child which have to be cleared in school itself.
- 15. In case of cheque bounce, parents will be requested to clear the dues immediately with penalty as levied according to bank norms. In case of any delay, School is entitled to make legal proceedings against the defaulting person.

- 16. Students will not be allowed to join classes from new session, until all the pending fee dues are cleared or until special permission from School Management is obtained. Also Management reserves the right to cancel the admission of any student at end of the session on basis of non-payment of fee dues or irregularity in fee deposition.
- 17. For Board classes, fee dues must be cleared before practicals. In case of delay, parents will have to deposit Post dated cheque with hand written application duly signed by parents.

NOTE: It is not the duty of the School Authorities to remind you to deposit the fee of your ward on time. School has no liability in providing records, in case fee book is lost by parents.

### **WITHDRAWAL**

- A month's notice in writing is required for withdrawal of any student. No Transfer Certificate shall be issued if a student has arrears.
- 2. Kindly note that we require at least THREE days for processing applications for certificates.
- 3. Forms must be given for T.C. only by parents/legal guardian atleast ten days in advance.
- 4. Students can be asked to leave the school for the following reasons:
  - (a) Indisciplinary conduct
  - (b) Detentionor repeated detentions in a class.
  - (c) Any other reason that the School Authorities may deem fit.

### **ATTENDANCE**

- 1. Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than seven consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her same struck off the rolls. Readmission may be granted only on payment of fresh Admission Fee provided the vacancy still exists.
- 2. All children are expected to attend the school on the opening day after each of the vacations. Those absent because of sickness must present a Medical Certificate before they are admitted to the classes.
- 3. The percentage could be relaxed on medical grounds but such students will not be eligible to receive any prizes.
- 4. A child returning to school after suffering an infectious or contagious disease should produce a doctor's fitness certificate.
- 5. The students must attain 75% attendance status of the total number of working days.

### **CURRICULUM AND EXAMINATIONS**

- 1. The School will shall follow the CBSE as well as the International Curriculum.
- 2. From Primary Level the study periods shall be of 50 minutes other than the traditional

35-40 minutes periods. These shall incorporate the E-Teaching and E-Learning concept which is the ethos of the Institution and these make the teaching process interactive and informative to its maximum.

- 3. To help the weak students pace up in their academics the concept of TUTORIAL CLASSES has also been incorporated.
- 4. FOR EXAMINATION the school shall follow the CBSE system. It shall be a system of continuous assessment and evaluation through Assignments, Project Work, Formative Assessments and two Summative (Terminal) Assessments.
- 5. The answer sheets of Formative Assessments (Class Tests) and Summative Assessments (Terminal Examinations) shall be shown to the parents in Parent-Teacher Meeting and the Progress Report is to be signed by the parents.
- 6. Average of the Internal Assessments and the Examinations shall decide the Promotion.
- 7. If any child is unable to give any Exam for whatever reason, proper application must be submitted for the same; otherwise the result of that child will be withheld.
- 8. Re-examination Will Not Be Conducted Under Any Circumstances.

GIRLS: Yellow Shirt with dark blue denim skirt; Navy Blue socks with Black leather shoes; Navy Blue ribbons (for girls with long hair) and Navy Blue hair band (Hosiery material) for all girls.


